

MAX Goes to the Movies (Virtually) Saturday, June 27th, 7:00 – 8:30 p.m.



This coming weekend marks the 50th Anniversary of Pride. Since we still can't do our monthly movie theater outings we've decided to watch the hit new mini-series "**Hollywood**" on Netflix that deals in great part with the LGBTQ community in a story about aspiring actors and filmmakers trying to make it in the film industry in the post-World

War II “Golden Age” of Hollywood (1947-48). The story – a mixture of fantasy and alleged facts – is based loosely on the 2012 memoir *Full Service: My Adventures in Hollywood and the Secret Sex Lives of the Stars*, written by Scotty Bowers (with Lionel Friedberg) in which Bowers alleges to have run a service station that doubled as a brothel to the Hollywood elite (both straight and gay) and a gateway to stardom.

Members are invited to watch the show on their own, using their Netflix account, then join us for a discussion about the show, using Zoom, on **Saturday, June 27th at 7 p.m.** To join the Zoom discussion, you **must register** on the MAX SF website. Those who register will receive instructions by email on Saturday, June 27th with the Zoom link and login details. The mini-series has seven episodes, each about 50 minutes long.
